Open house delights

A COMMUNITY space has been opened in the grounds of Leppington Public School.

The Leppington Community House was established through a partnership between Camden Council, Camden Community Connections and the school.

Camden mayor Greg Warren opened the house earlier this month.

The community house is designed to inform residents about future developments and community services

available in the Camden area and to give residents the opportunity to connect with each other over a cup of tea.

With the help of Bunnings, Narellan, a vacant former classroom was transformed into a child-friendly centre.

Cr Warren said the house would allow Leppington community members to stay in touch with what was happening in Camden.

"It will be a great resource for the community to come together," he said.

He said community groups such as playgroups and

mothers' groups would be able to use the house as well.

The community house will offer developmental play sessions on a weekly basis next month, and a schedule for events in 2012 will be developed after consultation with the community.

Leppington Community House will be open every Wednesday from 2pm to 3pm.
